2010 Scholarship Application

**Amount:** One scholarship in the amount of \$350 will be made available.

**Eligibility:** Applicants must be:

- A practicing Catholic.
- A member of St. Patrick's Parish in Onalaska, WI.
- A graduating high school senior who will be accepted to an accredited college, university, technical college, junior college, community college, trade school, etc, for the 2010 fall semester.

**Selection:** Students will apply for the scholarship by submitting the following documents by March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2010 (All applications submitted by mail must be postmarked by this date to be considered):

- A completed scholarship application form.
- One letter of recommendation from a faculty member on why the applicant should be considered for this award.
- An essay response to the question posed on page two of this application.

The recipient of this scholarship will be selected without regard to race, gender, or nationality.

**Payment:** The scholarship will be paid in full directly to the educational institution on behalf of the student after completion of the 2010 fall semester in good standing and with proof of second semester enrollment. If for some reason the student is unable to meet all of the criteria or eligibility items required for payment, the Knights of Columbus reserve the right to rescind the award.

**Criteria:** The following will be considered in determining the recipient of the scholarship award:

- Parish and community involvement (35%)
- Career aspirations (25%)
- Essay response (25%)
- Recommendation letter (15%)

(Percentages reflect the weight given to each category in the evaluation process)
